Funds descriptions

Strategic Research Project Fund (8510-18)

To speed up cancer research and develop new therapies, it is crucial to innovate and fund highly promising and trailblazing projects for which few or no publicly funded programs exist. The Strategic Research Project Fund acts as a catalyst providing leverage and opening the way to the discovery of new therapies against cancer.

Research Scholarships Fund (8510-17)

To have a significant impact on treating cancer, it is essential not only to accelerate the discovery of new therapies, but also to train the scientists of tomorrow. This Fund is focussed on research scholarships (internships, masters and PhD programs) to support the recruitment of students at the IRIC. Notably, the IRIC was the first in Canada to set up a graduate program in systems biology. Participants in this program are student researchers who contribute to the IRIC's mission on a daily basis.

Investigators' Recruitment Fund (8510-19)

With this Fund, the IRIC seeks to recruit the best researchers in the world. The Institute's success depends largely on its novel approach aiming to study the components of a biological process as a whole rather than as isolated occurrences. Top researchers are thus selected according to the multidisciplinary and complementary nature of their expertise. The IRIC was one of the first research centres in Canada to operate under this model.

Acquisition and Maintenance of Equipment Fund (8510-15)

The IRIC is located in an ultra-modern building meeting today's research requirements. Its 11 state-of-the-art technology platforms serve not only the IRIC's research teams, but scientific communities from Montreal, the province of Quebec, the country, and even abroad. This Fund is dedicated specifically to the acquisition and maintenance of equipments for those platforms.
